## The Council in Action

Council members contribute their time, expertise, and resources by serving on working committees.

### Community Action

Members identify the gaps in the health, welfare, and educational needs in the community and work to find solutions through the Council. They host an annual Agency Networking Fair.

Members collaborate with county agencies and businesses to educate our council members. They assist in the selection and scheduling of speakers for our monthly meetings.

### Public Relations

This committee promotes volunteer, agency and Council activities to the Gwinnett community. It also maintains the CCGC website.

### Membership Committee

This committee is responsible for developing recruitment strategies and the welcoming of members and guests each month. The resources of each member are published in a directory.
